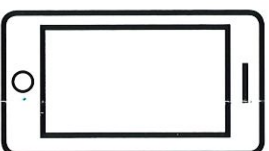
T.I.M.E. PROGRAM

The T.I.M.E. Program is a court diversion program for youth who have committed an offense in the Oak Park or River Forest Area. Youth are referred to T.I.M.E. by the two local police departments and other judicial programs.

T.I.M.E. is funded by and housed at Oak Park Township Youth Services.



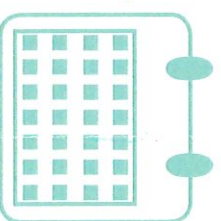
Youth are required to keep track of their hours and return the time sheet to the Program Manager before a completion letter can be submitted to the referral source.



Youth are required to contact the program manager for an initial interview.



At the interview, the Program Manager gathers information so they can best place the youth for the community service hours (usually between 10-30 hours). The community service sites are located in the Oak Park or River Forest area.



Once assigned, the youth are expected to contact the site personnel and make scheduling arrangements.
