**Prevail Emergency Assistance including:**

Eviction prevention / Short-term stabilization services  
Resource referrals / Public transportation passes for job interviews and medical appointments / Obtainment of identification


**Employment Readiness Services:**

One-on-one job coaching / Group soft skills training  
Job placement assistance / Computer lab

**What is Entry Point?** Entry Point is a **NEW** suburban-wide system designed to coordinate and maximize resources available to individuals and families who are at-risk or experiencing homelessness in Cook County.

**What is Housing Forward's role?** Housing Forward is one of four designated Entry Point Walk-In Centers in suburban Cook County providing in-person, comprehensive intake and referrals for those experiencing a housing crisis and matching them to available resources.
