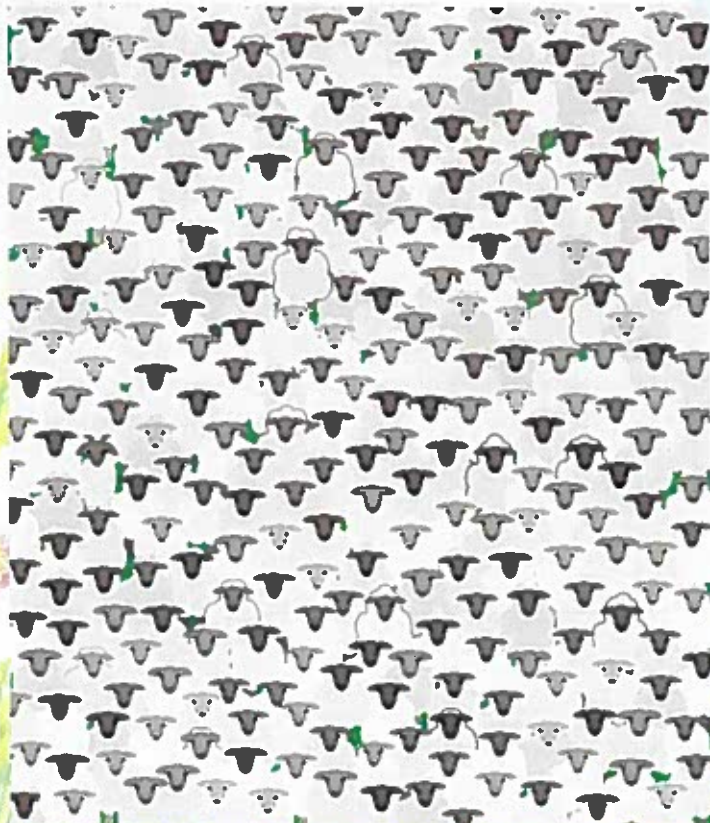
# Senior News of Forest Park
